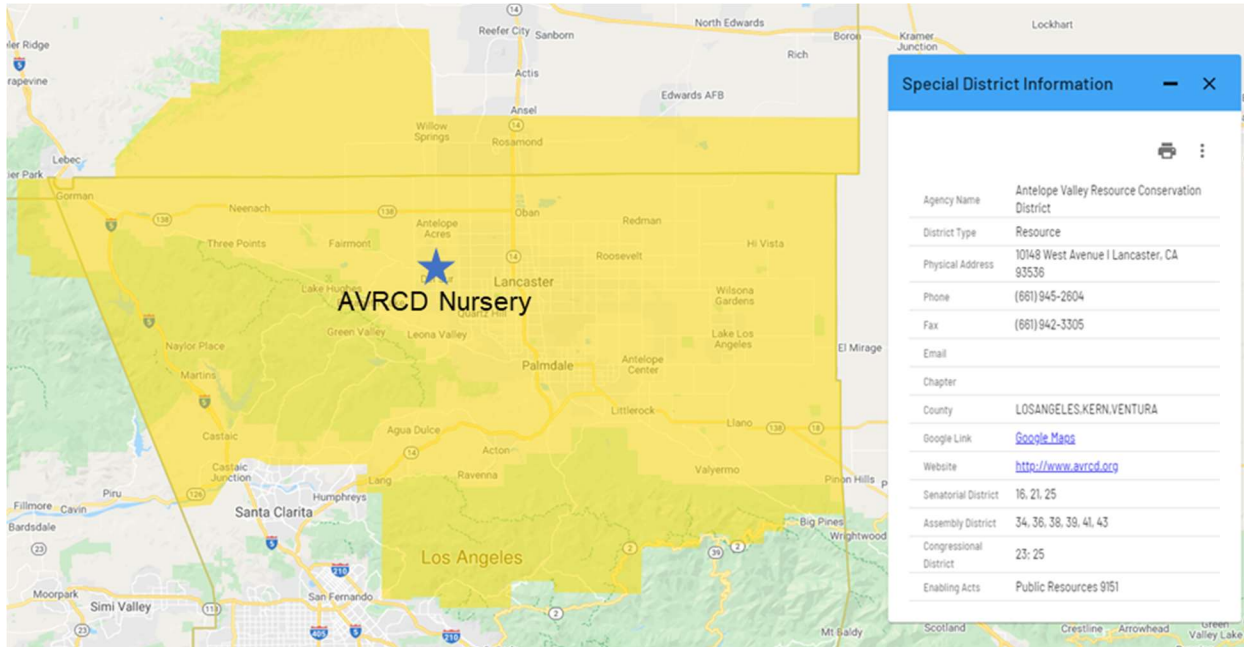


Lawn Reduction Rebate Process Guidelines

We pay upon completion of project. This means we have not set aside funds to pay you until your project is complete and your post-inspection is conducted.

Complete ALL Steps 1-8

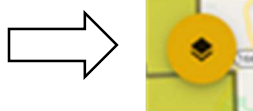
Step 1 - Verify Your Address is Within the Antelope Valley Resource Conservation District Service Area

At the link above with the Layers dropdown button, unselect **Counties** and then select **Resource Districts**. Zoom into the **Antelope Valley** area and **click on the AVRCD**. Once at the AVRCD, deselect **Resource Districts**, then the **AVRCD area becomes more transparent**.

Layers Dropdown Button



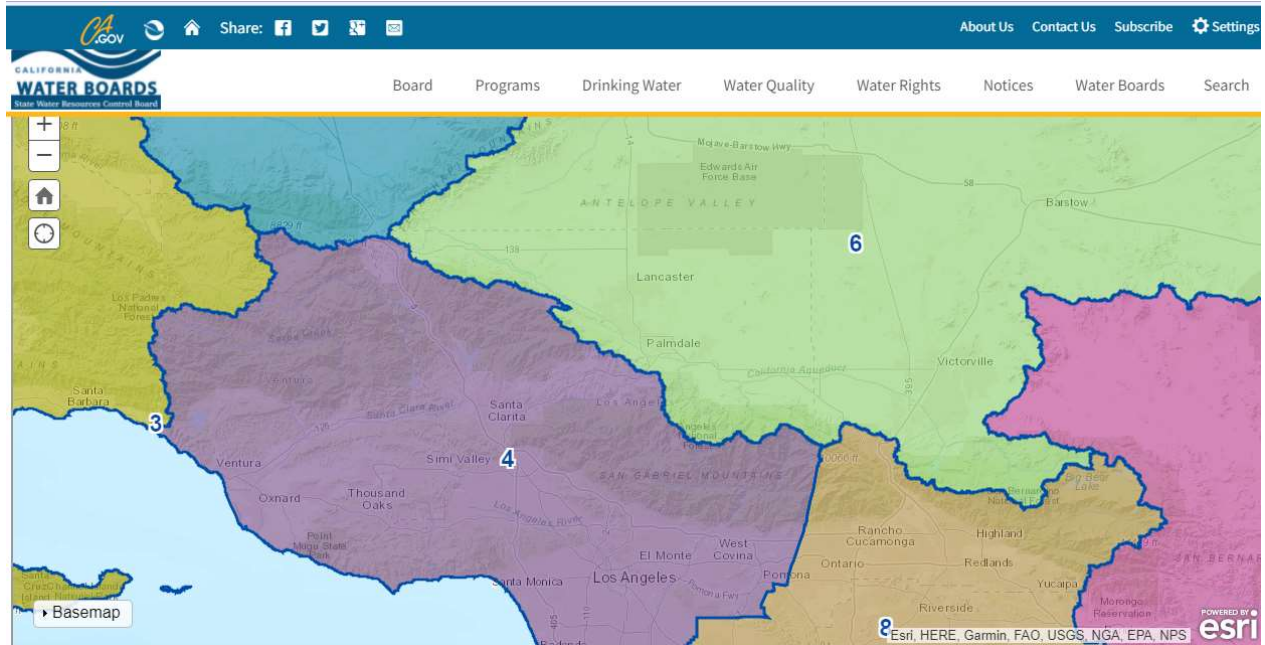

Step 2 - Verify Your Address is Within the *Lahontan Regional Water Quality Control Board*. (Shown on map as #6 in green) (Acton, Agua Dulce and areas within Los Angeles Region #4 - are not eligible)

Step 3 - Verify That No Other Lawn Rebate Programs Apply to Your Address

The AVRCD Lawn Reduction Rebate is **not available** where other Lawn Rebates are offered i.e., **Palmdale Water District, California Water Service** and **LA County Waterworks District** customers. (A copy of water bill must be submitted with application)

Step 4 - Submit Your Application

Once your application is received, AVRCD staff will provide general project feedback and contact you to schedule a pre-conversion inspection. During the inspection, staff will verify the measurements of the proposed project area, take photos, and confirm feasibility of the lawn reduction landscaping plan.

For **Landscape Design Assistance**, please check **Landscape Design Assistance** on application. If this option is selected, our landscape professional will contact you for an on-site consultation.

Step 5 - Notice to Proceed Must be Received

If everything looks good, you will be provided with a Notice to Proceed.

Step 6 - Convert Your Lawn

Work on your project! Once your lawn area has been removed and you are ready for planting. Submit photos of your yard showing that it is ready for planting and make a request for a Plant Materials Voucher.

Step 7 - Pick Up Your Plants

Visit AVRCD Nursery and pick up your plants. Ask for an extension if you need one. We will then schedule a post-inspection.

Step 8 - Receive the Rebate!

Payments typically take 120 days. The converted landscape must be maintained for five years minimum as a grass or lawn-free zone.
