

6th Annual Antelope Valley Windbreak Tree Planting Program

The Antelope Valley Windbreak Tree Planting Program provides qualified residents with free windbreak trees. We have identified your property as being in a prioritized wind zone. This means that you could benefit from free trees to help mitigate the effects of windblown dust, such as valley fever (a fungal disease), dust storms, property damage, air quality issues and more. These trees have a retail value of over \$450.

Pine trees will be distributed to residents who complete the application on the reverse and are selected to receive windbreak trees. A free tree planting and care workshop will be held at the AVRCD Nursery in Lancaster at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, October 12, 2019.

Timeline for Windbreak Tree Planting Program:

1. Applications: Due: Sept. 15, 2019
2. Selection: 9/16 - 10/06/2019
3. Notification: 10/07 - 10/09/2019
via email (please provide valid email)
4. Pick up/Delivery of Trees and free workshop: Saturday, October 12, 2019 @ 10:00 a.m. at the AVRCD Nursery at 10148 West Avenue I, Lancaster CA

How the Program Works:

1. Application: To qualify for participation in this windbreak tree program, simply complete the application on the reverse or go online to www.avrcd.org. Applications must be received by September 15, 2019.
2. Selection: Selection of tree recipients will be made by October 6, 2019.
3. Trees: If you are notified of selection, you will receive 10 free windbreak trees to pick up or have delivered on October 12, 2019. Trees can be picked up in Lancaster or delivered for \$25. Holes for tree planting can be drilled for a fee of \$25. Recipients are strongly encouraged to attend the tree planting and care workshop on October 12, 2019.
